- Disqualification may occur for reporting false information on this application.
- Rude and/or disrespectful behavior towards the People Helping People volunteers, or any abuse of the services People Helping People offers, will also result in being disqualified from the program.
- It is very important that you keep the information on your application updated, especially your phone number. If we cannot contact you about a delivery, it will result in your not receiving the delivery.
- We call with plenty of notice of the scheduled delivery date. Someone must be present to accept the delivery of boxes or they will be returned to the rectory and possibly given to someone else. It is your responsibility to call us and arrange for another delivery or pick up time if something comes up and you will not be available for the delivery
- We are volunteers doing our best to help you with a Thanksgiving, Christmas, and Easter delivery of donated food, paper products, cleaning products, and personal items. We are NOT banks to give out personal loans. Unfortunately we are NOT an "open all year" pantry. If you find that you are in need of more assistance during the year, please call the rectory. The staff at the rectory may be able to help you or direct you where to go for the help you need. The phone number there is 978-352-2024.
- We do our best to check the expiration dates on each of the donated food items as they are put on our shelves. Because we do have many volunteers helping and sometimes we are dealing with large amounts of donated items in a small space, it is possible that an item past its expiration date may accidentally be placed on the shelves. Many food items have codes on them now instead of dates making our job of ensuring food safety even more difficult. It is your responsibility to double check the dates and to use good judgment when eating items with codes on them.
